

خطبة الاول من شعبان Feb 24, 2023

إِنَّ الْحَمْدَ لِلَّهِ، نَحْمَدُهُ، وَنَسْتَعِينُهُ وَنَسْتَغْفِرُهُ، وَنَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنْ شُرُورِ أَنْفُسِنَا وَمِنْ سَيِّئَاتِ أَعْمَالِنَا، مَنْ يَهْدِهِ اللَّهُ فَلَا مُضِلَّ لَهُ، وَمَنْ يَضِلَّ فَلَا هَادِيَ لَهُ، وَأَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ وَأَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ. أوصيكم ونفسي بتقوى الله في السر والعلَم. يقول الله سبحانه:

”يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا اتَّقُوا اللَّهَ حَقَّ تَقَاتِهِ وَلَا تَمُوتُنَّ إِلَّا وَأَنْتُمْ مُسْلِمُونَ“

Verily, all praise is for Allah. We praise Him, we seek His assistance, and we ask for His forgiveness. And we seek refuge in Him from the evils of our selves. Whoever Allah guides, none can misguide. Whoever He misguides, none can guide. And I bear witness that there is no deity other than Allah and I bear witness that Mohammad is His slave and messenger. I advise you and myself to fear Allah as he should be feared, Allah swt said:

“O you who believe! Fear Allah as He should be feared and die not except in a state of Islam”

أيها الناس، الحمد لله رب العالمين، الرحمن الرحيم، الذي يهدي الذين اتبعوا رضوانه سبل السلام، ويخرجهم من الظلمات إلى النور بإذنه، ويهديهم إلى صراط مستقيم، ليفوزوا الفوز العظيم، هو الذي أرسل رسوله محمداً ﷺ بالهدى والدين الحق، ليظهره على الدين كله ولو كره المشركون. كان النبي ﷺ يصلي ويستريح، يصوم ويفطر في غير شهر رمضان، فهذه هي في طريقته ﷺ ومن رغب عنها فليس منه. وكان يكثر الصوم في شعبان.

فاتقوا الله تعالى وأطيعوه، وداوموا على ذكره، والتزموا سنة نبيكم، فإنَّ الأجل قريب والحساب شديد، والموت يأتي بلا موعد، ولا عمل بعد الموت، فعلى كل إنسان أن يحاسب نفسه ويستعد للقاء ربه.

كُلُّ نَفْسٍ ذَائِقَةُ الْمَوْتِ وَإِنَّمَا تُوَفَّقُونَ أُجُورَكُمْ يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ فَمَنْ رُحِخَ عَنِ النَّارِ وَأُدْخِلَ الْجَنَّةَ فَقَدْ فَازَ وَمَا الْحَيَاةُ الدُّنْيَا إِلَّا مَتَاعُ الْغُرُورِ

Oh people: All praise is due to Allah the entirely Merciful. The Most Generous Bestower. He bestowed Iman (faith) to His servants. He guided them to the best of deeds and the virtuous times in which rewards are multiplied.

The Prophet ﷺ used to offer a lot of acts of worship in general and he ﷺ used to perform the most voluntary fasts in the month of Shabaan. And with that,

he ﷺ used to pray and rest. He used to fast and break his fast on other days. This is his way and whoever turns away from it is not from him.

We need to be conscious of Allah Almighty and obey Him. And fill our time with His remembrance. And follow the sunnah of his prophet (saw) for the death is near and the accounting is severe. And death comes in an instant without notice. And there are no deeds after death. For there will be accounting and recompense. Allah swt says:

Every soul will taste death, and you will only be given your [full] compensation on the Day of Resurrection. So he who is drawn away from the Fire and admitted to Paradise has attained success. And what is the life of this world except the enjoyment of delusion.

وشهر شعبان هو شهر عظيم، يأتي بين الشهر الحرام رجب والشهر المبارك رمضان، وكان النبي ﷺ يصوم فيه الكثير من الصيام، كما روت عائشة (رضي الله عنها) في الحديث:

كَانَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ -صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ- يَصُومُ حَتَّى نَقُولَ: لَا يُفْطِرُ وَيُفْطِرُ حَتَّى نَقُولَ: لَا يَصُومُ وَمَا رَأَيْتُ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ -صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ- اسْتَكْمَلَ صِيَامَ شَهْرٍ قَطُّ إِلَّا رَمَضَانَ، وَمَا رَأَيْتُهُ فِي شَهْرٍ أَكْثَرَ مِنْهُ صِيَامًا فِي شَعْبَانَ” (البخاري: 1969، مسلم: 1156)

وأشار النبي ﷺ إلى سبب صيامه المتكرر في شعبان، كما روى في حديث أسامة بن زيد (رضي الله عنهما) الذي قال فيه:

قُلْتُ: يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ، لِمَ أَرَكَ تَصُومَ شَهْرًا مِنْ الشُّهُورِ مَا تَصُومُ مِنْ شَعْبَانَ، قَالَ: ذَلِكَ شَهْرٌ يَغْفُلُ النَّاسُ عَنْهُ بَيْنَ رَجَبٍ وَرَمَضَانَ، وَهُوَ شَهْرٌ تُرْفَعُ فِيهِ الأَعْمَالُ إِلَى رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ، فَأَجِبُ أَنْ يُرْفَعَ عَمَلِي وَأَنَا صَائِمٌ” (النسائي: 2357)

وقبل شهر رمضان، شهر الصيام والقيام وتلاوة القرآن وفعل الخير. وهذا الحديث يشكل أساسًا لذكر الله تعالى في أوقات الغفلة وإحياء الأوقات المهملة بأعمال الطاعة له فلها فوائد

And the month of Shabaan is a great month. It falls between the sacred month Rajab and the blessed month Ramadan. And the Prophet ﷺ used to perform plenty of fasts within it. As in the Hadith narrated by Aishah (may Allah be pleased with her) who said:

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ used to fast until we said: ‘He will not break his fast.’ And he used not to fast until we said: ‘He will not fast.’ And I never saw the Messenger of Allah ﷺ fast more in any month than in Shabaan.” [alBukhari 1969, Muslim 1156]

And the Prophet ﷺ indicated the reason for his frequent fasting in Shabaan. As was related in the Hadith of Osamah bin Zaid (may Allah be pleased with them) who said:

I said: ‘O Messenger of Allah, I do not see you fasting any month as much as Shaban.’ He said: ‘That is a month to which people do not pay much attention, between Rajab and Ramadan. It is a month in which the deeds are taken up to the Lord of the worlds, and I like that my deeds be taken up when I am fasting.’” [AnNisai 2357]

The Prophet ﷺ mentioned two reasons for his fasting in Shabaan. First, the inattentiveness of the people to it. And the reason for this is that Shabaan falls after the month of Rajab which is a sacred month. And Allah the Exalted said about the sacred months:

فَلَا تَظْلِمُوا فِيهِنَّ أَنْفُسَكُمْ التَّوْبَةَ: 36

So do not wrong yourselves during them

And before Ramadan and it is the month of fasting, night prayer, Quran and doing good. And this hadith is a basis for remembering Allah Almighty at times of inattentiveness.

أَقُولُ مَا تَسْمَعُونَ وَأَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ لِي وَلَكُمْ مِنْ كُلِّ ذَنْبٍ فَاسْتَغْفِرُوهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْعَفُورُ الرَّحِيمُ

I say what you have heard and I seek forgiveness from Allah for me and you from every sin. So seek forgives from Him, Verily He is Oft-Forgiving, the Most Merciful.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ، وَالصَّلَاةُ وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ، وَ أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

All praise is to Allah, and peace and blessings upon the Messenger of Allah, and I bear witness that there is no deity other than Allah and I bear witness that Mohammad is His slave and messenger.

أيها المسلمون:

الليلة الوسطى من شعبان (الخامس عشر)، ذكرت في حديثين ضعيفين لا ينبغي الاعتماد عليهما. ولا يوجد لها أي تفضيل عن أي ليلة أخرى، ولا ينبغي تخصيص يومها للصيام أو ليلتها للصلاة. بل هي مثل الليالي الأخرى. فمن كان يصوم عادة في شعبان، يصوم في الخامس عشر لأنه يصوم عادة في شعبان، ومن كان يصلي القيام بشكل منتظم، يصلي ليلة الخامس عشر لأنه عادة ما يصلي القيام. وليس لأنها الخامس عشر ومن المحرم صيام آخر يوم أو يومين من شعبان إذا كان ذلك كإجراء احترازي لرمضان. روى أبو هريرة (رضي الله عنه) أن النبي ﷺ قال:

لَا يَتَقَدَّمَنَّ أَحَدُكُمْ رَمَضَانَ بِصَوْمِ يَوْمٍ أَوْ يَوْمَيْنِ، إِلَّا أَنْ يَكُونَ رَجُلًا كَانَ يَصُومُ صَوْمَهُ، فَلْيَصُمْ ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمَ" (البخاري:1914، مسلم:1082)

فإذا تزامن مع يوم يصومه عادةً مثل يوم الاثنين أو الخميس، فلا ضرر في صيامه، لأنه لا ينوي من صيامه شهر رمضان

وفي كل حالة، ينبغي للمسلم تغيير حاله في شعبان. وينبغي له الصيام بكثرة وتلاوة القرآن فيه، حتى لا يكون من الغافلين ويستعد لشهر رمضان. حتى لا يأتي إلا وهو على علم بالصيام وتلاوة القرآن وأكثر اجتهادًا في العبادة خلال رمضان

نسأل الله تعالى أن يعلمنا ما ينفعنا، وأن يمنَّ علينا بالعمل بما نتعلم، وأن يساعدنا على ذكره، وأن يجعلنا ممن يحمده ويعبده بالطريقة الفضلى، إنه سميع مجيب.

The middle night (15th) of Shabaan was mentioned in two weak Hadiths which should not be relied upon. And it does not have any preference over any of the other nights. So one should not designate its day for fasting or its night for prayer. Rather it is like the other nights. So whoever regularly fasts in Shabaan, fasts on the 15th because he usually fasts during Shabaan. And whoever regularly prays night prayer, prays the night of the 15th because it is usual for him to observe the night prayer. And not because it is the 15th of Shabaan.

It is also prohibited to fast the last day or two of Shabaan if it is done as a precautionary measure for Ramadan. Abu Hurairah (may Allah be pleased with him) related that the Prophet ﷺ said:

None of you must fast one day or two days just before Ramadan, except in the case of a man who has been in the habit of observing a particular fast, for he may fast on that day. [alBukhari 1914, Muslim 1082]

So if it coincides with a day that he usually fasts such as Monday or Thursday, there is no harm in him fasting it because he does not intend through his fasting to include Ramadan.

And in every case, a Muslim should change his condition in Shabaan. And he should plentifully fast and recite Quran in it. So that he is not among the heedless and so that he prepares for Ramadan. So that it does not enter except that he is accustomed to fasting and reciting Quran and he more actively worships during Ramadan.

We ask Allah Almighty to teach us what benefits us. And to bestow on us acting upon what we learn. And to help us with remembering Him, being Grateful to Him to worship Him in the best manner. Indeed He is All Hearing, Answering.

هَذَا وَصَلُّوا وَسَلِّمُوا عَلَى نَبِيِّكُمْ كَمَا أَمَرَكُمْ بِذَلِكَ رَبُّكُمْ , فَقَالَ

I conclude with this and send prayers of blessings and peace upon your Prophet as your Lord commanded:

إِنَّ اللَّهَ وَمَلَائِكَتَهُ يُصَلُّونَ عَلَى النَّبِيِّ يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا صَلُّوا عَلَيْهِ وَسَلِّمُوا تَسْلِيمًا

Al Ahzaab (33) 56: Indeed, Allah confers blessing upon the Prophet, and His angels [ask Him to do so]. O you who have believed, ask [Allah to confer] blessing upon him and ask [Allah to grant him] peace.

اللَّهُمَّ اهْدِنَا فِيمَنْ هَدَيْتَ وَعَافِنَا فِيمَنْ عَافَيْتَ وَتَوَلَّنَا فِيمَنْ تَوَلَّيْتَ وَبَارِكْ لَنَا فِيمَا أَعْطَيْتَ وَقِنَا شَرَّ مَا قَضَيْتَ إِنَّكَ تَقْضِي وَلَا يُفْضَى عَلَيْكَ وَإِنَّهُ لَا يَذِلُّ مَنْ وَالَيْتَ تَبَارَكْتَ رَبَّنَا وَتَعَالَيْتَ

O Allah, guide us with those whom You have guided, grant us well-being among those You have granted well-being, be an ally to us along with those whom You are an ally to, and bless what You have bestowed upon us, and save us from the evil of what You have decreed. For verily You decree and none can decree over You. He whom You support can never be humiliated. Glory is to You, our Lord, You are Blessed and Exalted.

O Allah, We ask You for all that is good, in this world and in the Hereafter, what we know and what we do not know. O Allah, we seek refuge with You from all evil, in this world and in the Hereafter, what we know and what we do not know. O Allah, we ask You for the good that Your servant and Prophet has asked You for, and we seek refuge with You from the evil from which Your servant and Prophet sought refuge. O Allah, we ask You for Paradise and for that which brings one closer to it, in word and deed, and we seek refuge in You from Hell and from that which brings one closer to it, in word and deed. And we ask You to make every decree that You decree concerning us good

عِبَادَ اللَّهِ إِنَّ اللَّهَ يَأْمُرُ بِالْعَدْلِ وَالْإِحْسَانِ وَإِيتَاءِ ذِي الْقُرْبَىٰ وَيَنْهَىٰ عَنِ الْفَحْشَاءِ وَالْمُنْكَرِ وَالْبَغْيِ يَعِظُكُمْ
لَعَلَّكُمْ تَذَكَّرُونَ

Servants of Allah. Indeed, Allah orders justice and good conduct and giving to relatives and forbids immorality and bad conduct and oppression. He admonishes you that perhaps you will be reminded.

Remember Allah, the Great – He will remember you. Thank Him for His favors – He will increase you therein. And seek forgiveness from Him – He will forgive you. And be conscious of Him – He will provide you a way out of difficult matters. And, establish the prayer.
